PRIVACY POLICY

Types of Information We Collect

Personal Information

Personal information is information that is associated with your name or personal identity, whether true or not, about an individual who can be identified from that information or/and other information to which we have or is likely to have access. We use personal information to understand your needs and interests and to provide you with better service. The types of personal information you provide to us on these pages may include name, address, phone number, e-mail address, IDs, passwords, billing information, credit card information, information about your transactions in relation to the Services such as account balances, account history, and account activities as well as any other non-public information about you that is associated with or linked to any of the information.

Non-Personal Information

Log Files
